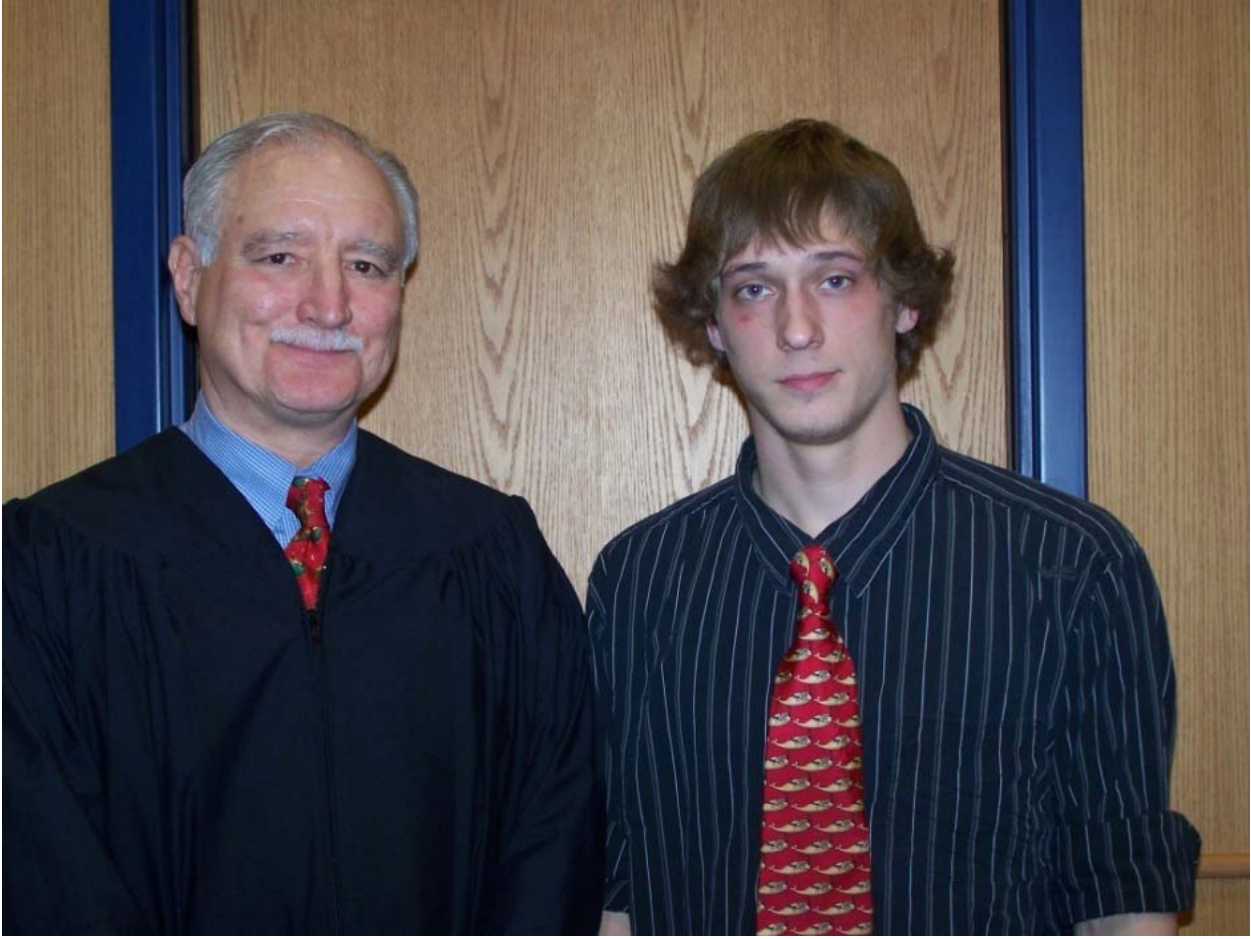














Here are some of the positive effects Drug Court has had on our family:

For my son (who was the participant):

1. He has been clean and sober for almost one year
2. He has learned to deal with his emotions in a positive and healthy manner
3. His medications are now effective in dealing with ADD and aggression
4. He is happy with himself

For me:

1. I have stopped drinking
2. I am going to AA regularly
3. I have learned to set boundaries
4. I have learned what is acceptable behavior
5. I have learned appropriate consequences for misbehavior

For my other, younger son:

1. He is not the object of his sibling's aggression anymore
2. He has learned that there are consequences for actions or inactions
3. I think he has learned that drugs and alcohol are bad choices
